**Integrated Case Management (ICM)** is the facilitation of family focused, strength based programmes for youth at risk. It provides social and vocational opportunities for young people in preparation for their future. In particular; education, training and employment opportunities.

ICM aims to improve social, health and economic outcomes for the young person and their family/whānau/aiga.

It is used to identify and improve on aspects of a young persons rehabilitation. Such as; drug and alcohol attachment, family dynamics, sense of connections and levels of self-esteem.

A key area used is the utilization of Strengthening Families for the coordination of services, or, coordinating wraparound services to work collaboratively with other agencies to develop a plan outlining the support each agency will provide for the family.

## REFERRAL CRITERIA

- Male or female between the age of ten and eighteen.
- Involved in lower level gang activity or at risk of becoming affiliated with a gang.
- Demonstrating negative behaviours such as low level offending, graffiti, fighting, bullying and truancy.
- Living or attending school in an ICM service delivery area.
- Family must consent to referral and support the plan.
